

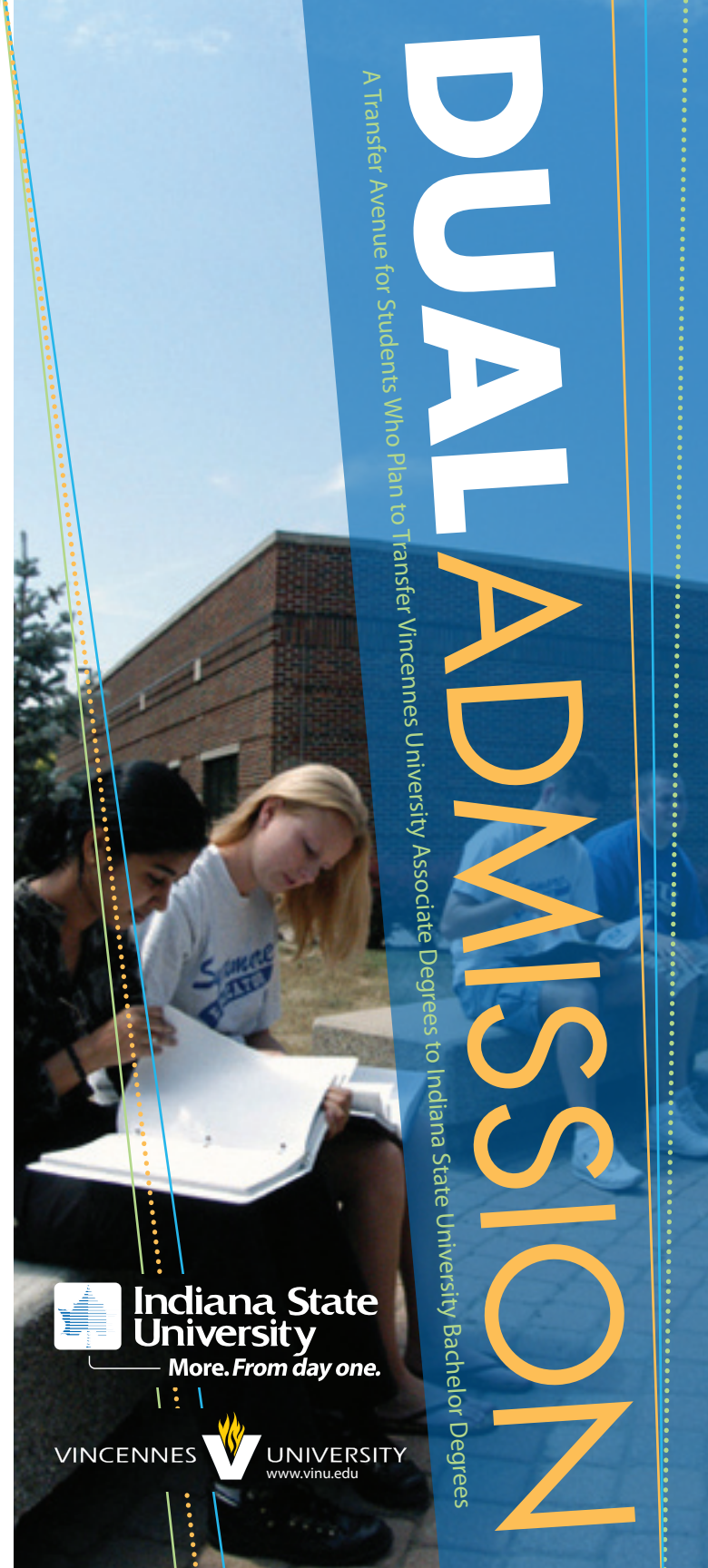

Dual Admission

Dual admission is an avenue that can make earning and transferring an associate degree from Vincennes University to a bachelor's degree at Indiana State an easy, convenient process.

This avenue of eventually completing a four-year degree allows you to:

- Complete an associate degree from Vincennes University;
- Transfer easily to a variety of programs at Indiana State University; and
- Complete an Indiana State University bachelor's degree—either on campus or via distance learning.

Dual admission allows you to be admitted to both Vincennes University and Indiana State at the same time. This program is an excellent opportunity for you to continue your education beyond the associate degree level, and advance your career with an Indiana State University bachelor's degree.

Program Benefits

Dual admission guarantees you, as an Vincennes University student, admission to Indiana State University programs for which you are eligible. In other words, to those programs for which you have successfully completed an associate's degree at Vincennes University.

Being part of this program guarantees you:

- Streamlined advisement
- Maximum credit transfer
- Smooth transition of financial aid services
- Links to ISU academic advisors
- Opportunities to compete for transfer scholarships

Transfer Central

To help you ensure your associate's degree credits at Vincennes University are compatible with transferring to a bachelor's program, Indiana State has established an office specifically to oversee students following this avenue. Transfer Central is designed to assist in the timely processing of your materials and to answer questions about the transfer process. Stay on Track

To make certain you are completing courses at Vincennes University that are transferable to Indiana State, take advantage of the new Course Applicability System (CAS). CAS is an on-line tool that works with Transfer Central to provide you with electronic evaluations of your credits from the minute you enroll at Vincennes University. Free to all students, CAS has many special features that include descriptions of ISU's courses, a list of your associate degree courses and grades, and a planning guide that shows how your courses transfer and apply to bachelor degree programs at Indiana State.

Dual Admission Requirements/Process

To be dually admitted, you must satisfy admission requirements for Vincennes University and check the box on the application. If you have already applied and/or been admitted to Vincennes University, you may apply for dual admission by completing and submitting the "Dual Admission Form" available at your Vincennes University admissions office. You must complete this form prior to earning your 24th credit hour at Vincennes University.

If you are dually admitted, you must satisfy the following requirements to maintain dual admission status and ensure admission to Indiana State University:

- Earn a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (2.25 for business; 2.5 for education)
- Complete a Vincennes University associate's degree
