G.O.L.D. (GRADUATES OF THE LAST DECADE) AWARD

I. Purpose

- A. The purpose of the G.O.L.D. Award is to provide recognition for the outstanding achievements of graduates of the past ten years of Indiana State University.

II. Eligibility for Award

- A. Only living graduates of Indiana State University are eligible. Degrees earned may be at the Associate, Bachelor, Master, Specialist, or Doctoral levels.
- B. The nominee should have been outstanding in his/her profession.
- C. The nominee should have made significant contributions benefiting his/her community, state, or nation.
- D. The nominee should have exhibited interest in Indiana State University and/or the Alumni Association since leaving the campus.

III. Nominations

- A. Nominations may be submitted by:
 - 1. Any department or faculty member of Indiana State University
 - 2. Alumni or friends of Indiana State University
- B. All nominations must be in writing and should be accompanied by complete biographical information.
- C. Regular nomination forms should be used and may be secured from the Office of Alumni Affairs, Indiana State University.
- D. Nominations should be postmarked not later than March 31 to be considered for an award the following fall.

IV. Selection of the Recipients

- A. The G.O.L.D. Awards Committee shall be composed of seven members, four of whom shall be alumni of Indiana State University, one of which will be a member of the Alumni Association Board of Directors, and three shall be faculty and/or staff members of Indiana State University.
- B. The G.O.L.D. Awards Committee shall recommend to the Alumni Association Board of Directors those persons it determines should receive the G.O.L.D. Award.
- C. The alumni members of the G.O.L.D. Awards Committee shall be appointed by the President of the Indiana State University Alumni Association and the members representing the University shall be appointed by the President of Indiana State University.
- D. Each member of the Committee shall serve a term of three years. There will be no reappointments for consecutive terms.
- E. The chairperson shall be the member of the Alumni Board. The director of Alumni Affairs or his/her designee shall be the Secretary and non-voting member of the Committee.

V. Number of Recipients

- A. There shall be no less than two (2), no more than five (5) G.O.L.D. Awards given in any one year; by consensus the Committee may recommend that a lower number be awarded.
- B. The Alumni Association Board of Directors strongly suggests the awards be made to individuals in as many fields of endeavor as possible, and shall truly reflect the broad range of our graduates.
- C. Final approval of the recipients of the G.O.L.D. Awards shall be made by the Alumni Association Board of Directors.

VI. Presentation of the Awards

- A. The awards shall be presented at the G.O.L.D. Awards Banquet each fall.
