Course Markings: The course is marked by double white lines and natural boundaries. Umpires will be stationed throughout the course. Splits will be given at every mile & kilometer marker.

Dressing Rooms: All competitors should dress before coming to the race site. There are no dressing facilities available at the course.

Banquet: The Championship banquet will take place on Saturday, November 18, 2006 in the ISU Hulman Center at 6:30pm. Each team will receive 10 complimentary admissions into the banquet for their official travel party (seven student athletes & three non student athletes). Institutions with individual qualifiers will receive one for the coach and one for the student athlete. Check in for the banquet is located at the South Entrance of the ISU Hulman Center (along Cherry Street). Parking will be available in the East lot (along 8th street). Additional dinners may be purchased at the banquet for \$20.
