## The Networks Scholarship

- ◆ Full In-State Tuition for 4 years valued at \$34,000
- ◆ \$3,000 Professional Development Account to be used over 4 years
- ◆ Laptop Computer or iPad



## Selection Criteria

Individuals planning on majoring in business at Indiana State University are eligible for this scholarship.

Student must meet 2 of 3 of the following academic requirements:

- ◆ Ranking in the top 15% of senior class
- ◆ Cumulative GPA of a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
- ◆ 1070 SAT (Critical Reading and Math) OR 1140 SAT (Evidenced-based Reading, Writing, and Math) OR 23 ACT

Must be accepted to ISU by **December 1st**

Must apply for the scholarship by **December 15th**

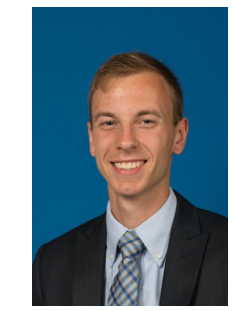

## How to Apply

1. Apply to Indiana State University at: [www.indstate.edu/apply](http://www.indstate.edu/apply) by **December 1st**
2. Once accepted to ISU, the Networks Scholarship Application will be provided for you to complete electronically
3. Ensure all required materials are received by the **December 15th** deadline
4. Candidates selected to move forward will be contacted after the first of the year for the interview weekend in the middle of February
