 - a. Dissertation
 - i. Congress to address definitions of who can chair dissertations, and what it means to be a member external to an area. (e.g., If a student is in math education, would that member be an external or internal committee member).
 - ii. Explore placement of faculty research profiles on website with a benefit of informing students about potential dissertation committee members that may be applicable to their research area.
 - iii. L. Sperry discussed exploring compensation for committee work including students signing up for EDUC 899P (for proposal) or EDUC 899D (for dissertation)--up to two semesters of each that would go on committee member course load.
 - b. Adjunct Handbook to be developed or addressed by 2019-2020 congress to include (but not limited to) the following points.
 - i. Hiring and meeting teaching qualification (done on FAD through associated coursework, professional licenses, professional experiences, and graduate faculty status)

- ii. Communicating payroll
- iii. Blackboard Requirements and Resources
- iv. Three-Week Attendance Reports
- v. Interim Grade Reports (if needed—undergraduate courses only)
- vi. Finals Week-classes need to meet
- vii. DO NOT-enroll student into Bb unless student is registered for course = serious violation
- viii. DO NOT-finish class early
