 - b) BCP I and the Maintenance of a 2.5 GPA (Judy Sheese). Our policy is that once a student is admitted to BCP I, they must maintain a 2.5 GPA to remain enrolled in BCP coursework. There is a formal check of the GPA at admission to BCP I and before admission to BCP II. There appears to be inconsistency in the monitoring of GPA during BCP I from semester-to-semester. ORR can run a report each semester that shows all teacher education students with a GPA below 2.5. It may be possible to report all teacher education majors' GPA; someone would need to check with ORR. ESS

would be willing to request that report and distribute to secondary and all-grade program coordinators. That may assist advisors in regular oversight and monitoring. There was discussion regarding the benefits and drawbacks of a strict enforcement of 2.5 compared to allowing flexibility. The group will reconsider the topic at a future meeting.

- 6. Dean's Report Brad Balch. Not present.
- 7. Associate Dean's Report Linda Sperry. Dean Balch is traveling for development. There was a Teacher Education Advisory Council (TEAC) meeting on 1/24/23 with good discussion. Counselor Day on Campus is scheduled for 2/1/23 to provide free professional development for school counselors; over 100 participants are registered to attend.
