### MICHIANA /SURBER SCHOLARSHIP

In October 2003, in honor of Richard F. Surber, Michiana Resources established the Surber scholarship. Richard Surber was a leader in the field of special education in Indiana for many years. He was also one of the founding board members of LaPorte County Sheltered Workshop which is now known as Michiana Resources.

In establishing the Surber scholarship, it is the intention of Michiana Resources to encourage and support the pursuit of teaching careers in special education and in so doing remembering the career and achievements of an outstanding leader in the field.

An award of five hundred dollars (\$500) will be paid to the students selected as the winner of the Surber scholarship. The Michiana/Surber Scholar Committee appointed by the Michiana Resources Board of Directors will select the winner. Applications must be received by July 1, 2010. The scholarship recipient will be selected on the basis of demonstrated commitment to the field of special education, academic achievement, and community engagement. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Resident of LaPorte County
- Active Enrollment at a University or College
- Junior or Senior Status
- A GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Demonstrated community engagement
- Personal essay on commitment to the field of Special Education
