AWARDS PROCEDURES

The \$1000 scholarship may be shared if there are multiple recipients.

Applications must be received by May 31, 2010. Recipient(s) will be notified in July 2010 and the award shall be paid in September 2010. The recipient(s) are invited to attend and be recognized at our Fall and Spring meetings.
