MCKEE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The **McKee Family Scholarship** was established in 1985 by Dale F. and Nancy J. McKee following the death of Dale's mother, Gertrude E. McKee. Family, friends and colleagues have since contributed to the scholarship to honor or remember family members.

Clyde M. McKee, a native of Merom, Indiana, was a first generation college student and was graduated from Indiana State Teachers College in 1931. His wife, Gertrude, was not a graduate, but maintained a longtime interest in Indiana State as part of Clyde's association and later when their son, Dale, attended Indiana State beginning in 1954.

After teaching in Indiana schools for a number of years, Dale McKee began a long career at Indiana State in 1965. Until his retirement in 1998, Dale served Director of Alumni Affairs and as Executive Vice President of the ISU Foundation. His wife, Nancy J. McKee, joined the faculty of the ISU School of Nursing in 1966 and retired in 1998 as a professor in the school having served a brief time as Acting Dean.

All three of Dale and Nancy's children earned baccalaureate degrees from Indiana State University. Craig (1979), Elizabeth (1983), and Christopher (1987). Craig's wife Diann Ehrlich McKee (B.S., 1983), serves as an ISU administrator. The McKee family traces its association to Indiana State University over more than seven decades and recognizes the University's profound influence on all of its members.

The **McKee Family Scholarship** in the amount of \$1,000.00 is offered to an Indiana State University student meeting the following criteria:

- Recipient must be a resident of Indiana or have graduated from an Indiana high school.
- Recipient should have completed at least 25 credit hours with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Recipient should have demonstrated financial need.
- The selection committee may give preference to students who provide evidence of an interest in pursuing student activities and contributing to the life of the University in a non-academic setting.
- The committee may renew the scholarship to a prior recipient.

A completed application, an official transcript, and a letter of recommendation from a member of the ISU faculty should be returned to the ISU Foundation, Gillum Hall, Suite 320, Terre Haute, IN 47809 no later than March 16, 2009.
