The Rebecca Johnson Honors Program Award

This endowed scholarship was established by Dr. David L. Johnson in loving memory of his wife, Rebecca A. Johnson, who earned a B.S. degree in Nursing from Indiana State University, an M.S. in Nursing from Indiana University in Indianapolis, and a D.N.S. degree from the University of California at San Francisco. She taught occasionally for the nursing school at ISU and worked for Planned Parenthood of the Wabash Valley. She also was a Nurse Practitioner for Union Hospital, assisting with the program for the rural medicine in Brazil, Indiana.

The recipient shall be a Nursing major in good standing in the ISU Honors Program.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Preference will be given to student candidates for this award who:

1. Have earned a minimum of 30 semester hours (a minimum of 12 hours of Honors at ISU) with a GPA of 3.0 or higher overall and in Honors course work.
2. Demonstrate financial need.

OBLIGATIONS FOR AWARD RECIPIENTS

Award recipients are expected to:

1. Submit a written essay describing the benefit derived from the scholarship to the University Honors Program office on completion of the experience.
2. Commit to promotion of Honors Program participation among Nursing majors.
