



ISU College of Nursing, Health, & Human Services Nursing Challenge Exam Instructions

To initiate the process for the 4 CSM's (customized study materials) and/or Nursing Departmental Challenge Exams, you will need to be completely admitted to the university and have a SID# (student ID number), before you are able to complete your first exam.

You purchase the four CSM's from TCN (The College Network - 800-395-3276), but take the exam through ISU on ISU's Blackboard website. These four are N106, N224, N328, and N330. If you do not complete an exam on your first attempt successfully, you will be required to show proof of purchase from TCN to **Carol Layton** before your second attempt of the exam.

For the Fall 2009 semester, all four (N106, N224, N328 and N330) will need to be completed and passed before being admitted into the nursing program for the June 1, 2009, nursing application deadline.

Nursing Departmental Challenge Exam Courses:

- 1) Nursing 106: Mental Health Aspects of Nursing (2 credit hours)
- 2) Nursing 224: Nursing Care of Adults (5 credit hours)
- 3) Nursing 328: Nursing Care of the Child and Family (4 credit hours)
- 4) Nursing 330: Nursing Care of the Childbearing Family (4 credit hours)
