Priority Registration ends soon!

Please be aware that Priority Registration ends this Friday, December 1, 2006. If you have not already registered for Spring classes, please do so immediately! All students, regardless of their number of earned credit hours, can register for Spring classes during this final week of Priority Registration.

If you are a first or second year student, you will need to contact your academic advisor in order to discuss class choices and to get your PIN. Please remember, though, that your academic advisor is much more than a PIN distributor! It is entirely appropriate to talk with your advisor about career goals and options, graduate school, volunteer and service learning opportunities—to name just a few. Your academic advisor is an educational resource for you!

If you are unsure who your academic advisor is, you can run your DARS to find out. Or, please call the Department at (812) 237-2445 and we can help you.

Registration for Spring classes will be unavailable from December 2nd through December 6th. Registration will resume on December 7th with a \$10 drop/add fee charged for each transaction resulting in a schedule change. The last day to add classes for the Spring semester is January 14, 2007.
