

Indiana State University Racquetball Policies

Court Use Policies

- All participants must present a current Indiana State University ID or pay the daily use fee.
- Courts are limited to a maximum of one hour of play. The court may be kept longer if a reservation has not been made on that court for the time slot following.
- All participants must wear court shoes. Street shoes, marking shoes, and bare feet are prohibited.
- The use of racquetball approved lensed eyewear is required.
- All racquets must have a protective bumper and wrist strap.
- Racquets and racquetballs are available for checkout. Individuals assume full responsibility of the equipment that has been checked out.
- A fee will be assessed for lost, stolen, or damaged equipment.
- For your protection keep all clothing, bags, etc. in a locker not in areas around the racquetball courts.
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- Avoid striking the court walls with racquets. Members must refrain from deliberate abuse of courts. Deliberately striking the walls, floors, etc. will result in loss of court privileges.

Reservation Procedures

Eligibility: Students, faculty, staff and their spouses or dependants may make a reservation. Proof of eligibility (ID) must be shown when claiming a court.

Community members and those paying one time fees are NOT eligible to make reservations.

- Court reservations can be made Monday - Friday by calling 237-4097 between the hours of 8am - 4pm.
- Courts will be reserved on the hour for **one** hour. The court may be kept longer if a reservation has not been made on that court for the time slot following. Staff will attempt to assign reservations so that a court is not reserved for two time slots in a row.
- All persons shall be restricted to one reservation per day.
- Reservations may be made for current week only, Monday through Sunday.
- All players must check in at the Equipment Desk prior to entering their reserved court. Reserved courts must be claimed within 10 minutes of reservation time. Courts not claimed within the 10 minute time period become open courts.
- Cancellations will be accepted up to one hour prior to the court reservation time without being penalized.
- No shows for reservations may result in the loss of reservation privileges.
