RULES and REGULATIONS GOVERNING
LAPTOP SCHOLARSHIP AWARD
2013 – 2014

Laptop Scholarships are awarded to first-year degree-seeking students enrolling in the Fall 2013 term who have achieved an overall 3.0 high school GPA, on a 4.0 scale, while meeting the requirements for an Indiana Core 40 Diploma, or its out-of-state equivalent. Admission and all of these requirements must be achieved by June 15th.

1. I understand that I am obligated to return the awarded laptop to Indiana State University within 30 days if
 - a. I withdraw from Indiana State University any time prior to January 13, 2014 OR
 - b. I discontinue enrollment from Indiana State University any time prior to January 13, 2014.
2. I understand that if I fail to return the awarded laptop per the laptop return policy (www.indstate.edu/scholarships/laptop-policy.htm) by the designated date, the cost of the laptop will be charged to my student account and an administrative hold will be placed on my student record, preventing registration and the release of my transcript and/or diploma.
3. I understand that I am responsible for any tax liability for the awarded laptop. Questions regarding your tax responsibilities should be directed to your tax advisor.
