RULES and REGULATIONS GOVERNING  
ROTC TEXTBOOK AWARD  
2013 – 2014**

1. ROTC Textbook Awards are offered to an unlimited number of first-year students who have demonstrated solid academic performance in high school and are enrolled in either the Air Force or Army ROTC program at ISU. To retain this scholarship, the student must:
  - A. enroll as a full-time student each semester (minimum of 12 credits) and successfully complete a minimum of 30 credit hours each academic year. This will enable the student to successfully progress toward graduation within four years.
  - B. enroll in a full academic year of ROTC classes; the ARTC 181/182 sequence or the MS 101/102 sequence as a freshman and in the ARTC 281/282 sequence or the MS 201/202 sequence as a sophomore.
  - C. maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 as measured at the end of each academic year for the duration of eligibility.
2. The ROTC Textbook Award is good for a total of three consecutive semesters of enrollment.
3. A student who withdraws or discontinues enrollment for one or more semesters may request renewal for a future semester by writing to the University Scholarship Office **before** withdrawing. The petition form is available at [www.indstate.edu/scholarships/petition.htm](http://www.indstate.edu/scholarships/petition.htm) The request should state the student's name (including any changes), student identification number, reason(s) for withdrawal, and the semester he/she is planning to re-enroll. Students who withdraw or discontinue full-time yearly enrollment without filing a written request and getting approval for the reinstatement of the scholarship will forfeit their award. Once the scholarship is lost, it cannot be reinstated.
4. Semesters in which a student enrolls are charged against the offer regardless of completion of classes, incomplete grades or no grades.
