This online service allows students to set appointments with career coaches and sign up for workshops and events. Additionally, students are able to search and apply for internships and jobs posted specifically for ISU students. To access Handshake, students must log into their MyISU portal or the Handshake app.
Focus 2 Career is an online exploration tool that allows students to assess their career-relevant personal qualities and explore career fields and academic majors that are compatible with their assessment results. Visit www.indstate.edu/career-center/focus2 and use "Sycamores" as the access code. We recommend making an appointment with a Career Coach to discuss assessment results.
Big Interview is an online virtual interview tool that allows students to practice a variety of interview questions by recording themselves and watching it back. It also provides many instructional videos to watch. Students can create a free account at http://indstate.biginterview.com using their ISU email to login. Students can start with the tutorials or jump right into practicing questions.
Candid Career provides thousands of informational videos for individuals in all stages of career exploration and planning. Explore Careers videos highlight individuals based on their industries, career title, or college major, while Get Hired videos provide helpful information on professional attire, job and internship searches, interviewing, & more.
Jobscan is a résumé optimization online resource that compares the content of a Jobscan student's résumé to a job description of their choice. Jobscan provides suggestions to improve résumés or cover letters that are specific to the needs of a targeted job. To gain access to Jobscan, students must email their name and major to isu-career-center@indstate.
What Can I Do With This Major? helps connect academic majors to careers. This site provides information to students exploring multiple majors or searching for information about their chosen field. Each major has information about the industries and employers that often hire students with these majors and how to get started in a particular field.
