Brown presented the proposal from Arts and Sciences for revision of the Liberal Studies Human Interaction BS program repurposing the former Corrections Ed program to a General Studies bachelor's degree. Many students reach the 90 credit point and do not finish a degree. This program would provide a path to complete a college program. The assessment plan is complete and approved.
- 4. Continuation of Senate Charge #3: Implement the high credit hour/long time to completion policy passed by the Faculty Senate in 2012-2013. The committee discussed the proposals concerning El Ed. The proposal will remain at 86 credits. The proposed reduction to 77 credits was not approved by the unit. The proposals from the COT were discussed. It is desired to summarize Appendix B to gain a better understanding of other institutions credits in the various majors.
