- 3. A discussion the proposal from Kinesiology, Recreation and Sport for creation of a new Foundation Studies UDIE course, PE 333 noted the need for the addition of "FS:2010 UDIE" language to the catalog copy.

A discussion of the proposals from Science Education for creation of a new Foundation Studies LS course, SCED 100, SCED 100L resulted in the need for the addition of a statement: "Restrictions: Must be enrolled in the following fields of study: El, Pre El Ed....." to the catalog copy. The Committee also needs a syllabus for the course.
- 5. A. Payne presented the proposal from Built Environment for creation of a new BA/BS in Architectural Engineering Technology, (ArET). Discussion resulted in requesting a response concerning the ability to complete the degree in seven semesters and a recommended sequence.

- 6. Continuation of Senate Charge #3: Implement the high credit hour/long time to completion policy passed by the Faculty Senate in 2012-2013. The committee discussed the proposals concerning Music. Requests for four year plans, justifications, and accreditation information resulted from the discussions.
