ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS
2006-2007



- * Spring 2007, **55%** (158/288) of student-athletes are on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll (3.0+ semester GPA), *the eighteenth consecutive semester maintaining 50% of student-athletes or higher on the honor roll.*
- * Overall, student-athletes have a mean cumulative GPA of **3.04** after the spring semester.
- * **53%** (153/288) of all student-athletes have a 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA.
- * **48%** (57/119) of female student-athletes have a 3.5 or higher cumulative GPA after spring 2007; **77%** of all female student-athletes have a 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA.
- * The percentage of student-athletes in poor academic standing is **5%** (15/288) after spring 2007.
- * **Women's Tennis** (7/7) and **Women's Golf** (6/6) had **100%** of team members above the 3.0 semester mark in spring 2007, highest among all ISU athletic teams. **Women's Cross Country** followed in the percentage of student-athletes on the honor roll with **82%** (9/11).
- * **Women's Tennis** has the highest team cumulative GPA with a **3.69** after the spring 2007 semester; following closely behind was Women's Golf with a **3.59**. **Men's Cross Country** achieved the highest GPA on the men's side with a **3.41**.
- * Showing the biggest improvement in team cumulative GPA was **Women's Cross Country**, increasing .13 of a point.
- * Improving in percentage of team members on the honor roll in spring 2007 was **Women's Golf** with **100%**, up from 83% in fall 2006.
- * The Missouri Valley and Gateway Conferences will recognize **140** ISU student-athletes for Conference Honor Roll (MVC = 3.20 or higher semester GPA; Gateway = 3.00 or higher).
- * In the past year, **five ISU athletic teams have been ranked nationally** due to their academic successes. These teams include: Women's Soccer, Women's Track, Women's Cross Country, Volleyball, and Men's Cross Country.
- * Five members of the Football team were named to the Gateway Football Conference All-Academic Team, a league-high. **Kyle Hooper** was named to the first team and second team recipients were **Carl Berman, Bryan Jackson, Ben Schmidt** and **Fred Staugh**. **Bryan Jackson** was also named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District 1st team.

- * Volleyball was recognized as a national All-Academic Team for the 8th straight year.
- * Two of the Men's Cross Country members were named to the 2006 MVC Scholar-Athlete Team. **Sean Bowman** and **David Santelik** both earned this honor.
- * For Women's Soccer, **Lauren Podolski** was selected to the 2006 MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team.
- * **Laura Engle** and **Dani Prince**, Women's Cross Country, were named to the MVC Scholar-Athlete Team. This is the third straight year **Engle** has earned the honor.
- * Two members of the Women's Basketball team, **Laura Rudolphi** and **Rachel Maenpaa**, received Academic All-District Five Teams. Rudolphi was named to the first team, while Maenpaa was named to the second team. This award is sponsored by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). This marks the second consecutive season in which two Sycamores have earned this honor.

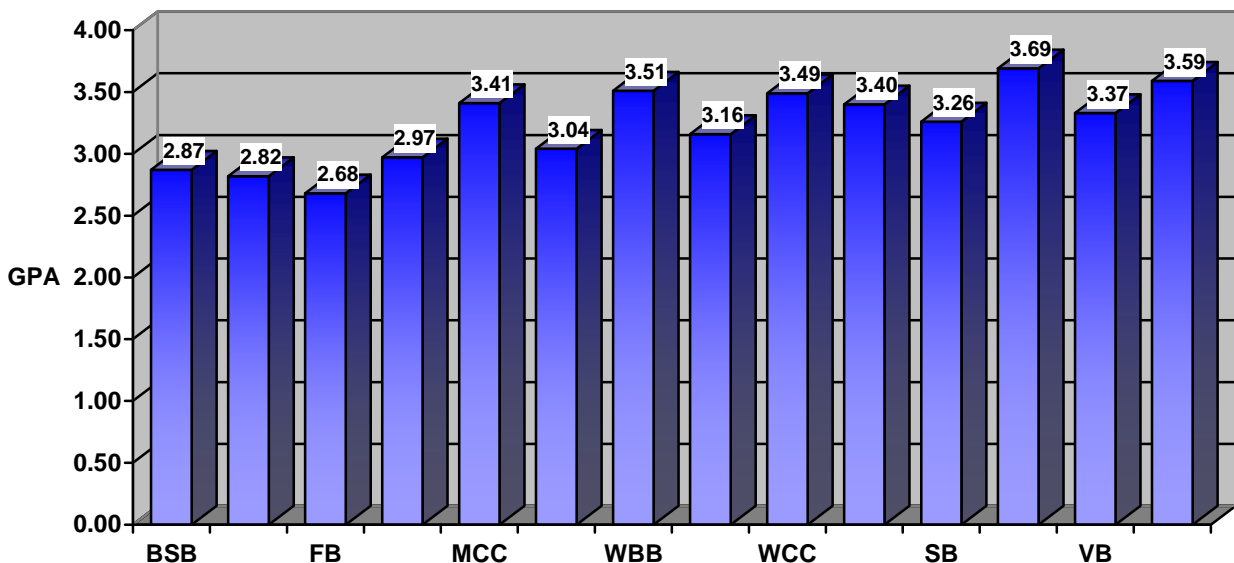

Maenpaa were also named to the MVC Scholar-Athlete First team, while **Leah Phillips** was named to the second team. Continuing her accolades, **Rudolphi** was selected for the Academic All-American Team and the MVC Scholar Athlete of the Year.

- * **Trent Wurtz** was named to the MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team, while **Adam Arnold** received second team accolades, for Men's Basketball. **Wurtz** was also named to the CoSida Academic All-District V First Team.
- * Three members of the softball team were selected to the MVC Scholar-Athlete Teams. **Jackie Chomicki** and **Meredith Simpson** were named to the First Team, while **Locoangeli** received Honorable mention. This is Chomicki's third consecutive year being recognized.
- * For Women's Tennis, **Joanne Schickerling**, **Jennifer Migan** and **Sarah Galparoli** were named to the MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team.
- * **Anton Tsymbalov** and **Michael Wenham** was named to the MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team, for Men's Tennis.
- * Indiana State placed 9 members on the 2007 MVC Scholar-Athlete Team for **Men's and Women's Track**. The list included two women and seven men for the Sycamores.
