Description of major: The Human Resource Development (HRD) Program combines a core curriculum with directed electives that support the student's work background or allows students to develop specialized areas of expertise. Content is based on the disciplines of education, business, psychology, and related behavioral sciences. Required studies in the major are drawn from the competency studies from the Association for Talent Development (ATD) and the Society of Human Resource Management (SHRM). This program allows students to learn the process of improving learning and performance in individual group and organizational contexts through domains of expertise such as lifelong learning, career development. Students are also given the knowledge and skills in a variety of roles for HRD for business education and industry.
