

Steps and timeline for PAFT applicants to apply for the fall semester

- 1. All applicants to be considered into the PAFT program must first apply to Indiana State University through the ISU Admissions Department.
 - o https://www.indstate.edu/apply
 - Once applied to ISU and all requirements are met, you will receive a formal letter via mail or electronically stating your general acceptance into the university.
 - PLEASE NOTE: This is not acceptance into the PAFT program.
 This is just acceptance into the University's College of Technology.
- 2. Once formally accepted, you will be added into the ISU Aviation Department technology non-designated section to be considered for the PAFT program.
 - Please read all mail and/or email sent to you up to this point carefully as it will explain vital information regarding the next steps toward the PAFT application process.
 - If you have not done so already, please ensure your sycamore student account portal is set up and active to receive any further information/instructions.
- 3. Once you're inside the Aviation Technology non-designated system, students must continue the application process further to complete the official PAFT application within the Aviation Department.
 - o This will be through the Slate software program.



<u>Items required for PAFT application to be considered.</u>

- o GPA 2.5 or greater.
- o SAT score(s)
- Private Pilot Certificate (recommended)
 - A private pilot certificate is not required prior to entry into the PAFT program. However, higher acceptance considerations could be possible for those who have and/or obtain a private pilot certificate.
 - Additional flight time and experience will also be considered and evaluated during the PAFT flight student section process. If you have any previous flight training experience, please include it when you apply!
- 4. Once your PAFT application is completed, you will receive all further notifications regarding your application via university sycamore email.
 - All communication from this point on should be found on your university sycamore email account. Please ensure you are checking emails regularly. Especially as it gets closer to the application deadline.
 - Once the application deadline closes for PAFT consideration, the aviation department will review all applications submitted and determine which applicants are the most qualified.
 - Please note: There is a limited number of flight slots available each year due to the competitive nature of the aviation industry.
 - Due to limited availability into the PAFT program, we are pleased to announce our alternative pathway into PAFT!

<u>Timeline & Deadlines on when to apply for PAFT consideration</u>

(*For change of major students*) August 31st - deadline to request to change major open (send request to ISU-AVT2@indstate.edu)

October 1st – PAFT applications open for fall semester

January 15th - deadline to apply for Fall semester

January 15th - deadline for request to change major

February 6th - deadline for Aviation Management (AM) students to meet the requirements for alternate path into PAFT.

- Requirements for alternate pathway option includes, Private Pilot Certificate, GPA 2.5, FAA medical, Full time)

March 15th - notice of Acceptance letter.

March 30th - deadline to accept offer.
