Admission Teacher Education (Option A only)

The student must hold a baccalaureate degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater and no grade below C in the professional education courses. Licensing in the State of Indiana requires passing the PRAXIS I (PPST or CPPST) and the relevant PRAXIS II test--Content Specialty. The student must pass all sections of PRAXIS I in order to take Phase II, III, IV courses. The student must take all relevant PRAXIS II tests and score within one standard measure of the State score in order to take Phase IV courses. **Admission to the Teacher Education Program (TEP) is required of all students prior to enrolling in professional education courses beyond Phase I.** Note, SPED 226, EPSY 341 may be completed during Phase I, II, or III.
