	**The Culminating Experience must be completed during the last semester of course work or after completing at least 24 semester hours of the approved program of study.		

NOTES:

1. In general, at least one half of the 33 credit hrs must be in courses numbered 600 or above.
2. Contract courses (509, 603, 679, etc) require an executed contract form. These contracts must be approved by the instructor and advisor. The purpose of these courses is to provide the graduate student the opportunity for more advanced courses in the area of specialization. Any such course and /or any 500 level courses in which undergraduate students are enrolled require additional activities on the part of the graduate student in terms of research and research writing.
3. IF TMGT 699-Thesis is selected as the culminating experience: The student chooses three graduate faculty, two from the department and one outside the department.
4. If TMGT 697 – Graduate Project is selected as culminating experience: The student chooses three faculty of which two must be graduate faculty.
5. Maximum of two special topics, e.g., 603.
6. Maximum of one independent study, e.g., 679.
