Complete a minimum of <u>124</u> credits with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.25. Complete the business and economics courses with an average of 2.25 or higher. Complete at least 50 credits at the 300-400 level. Complete BEIT 492 with a grade of C+ or higher. Complete all courses in the major with a 2.50 gpa or higher and achieve a gpa of 2.50 or higher for all courses taken. Complete BEIT 307, 317, 320, 336, and 337 with a 2.50 or higher g.p.a. for this block of courses with a “C” or better in each course. Complete each course in Phases I, II, and III of the Professional Education sequence with a grade of “C” or higher and achieve a g.p.a. of 2.50 or higher for all of these courses. Pass Praxis II at the minimum level of competency or higher. Complete Student Teaching satisfactorily.
