Complete BEIT 317, 320, 336, and 337 with a 2.50 or higher g.p.a. for this block of courses with a “C” or better in each course. 8. Complete each course in Phases I, II, and III of the Professional Education sequence with a grade of “C” or higher and achieve a g.p.a. of 2.50 or higher for all of these courses. 9. Pass Praxix II at the minimum level of competency or higher. 10.
