| Eligibility | <p>Open to High School Seniors. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. Applicants must have been admitted to the University for enrollment starting in the Fall 2024 semester before applying for the scholarship. | Media | <p>All art media are eligible.</p> |
| Number of Works | <p>8 to 12 works of art in a digital portfolio (PowerPoint format) completed by applicant and/or a written article or research paper (for those interested in pursuing the Art History program).</p> |
| Awards Available | <p>Up to 10 Creative & Performing Arts Awards between \$3,000 and \$6,000 are awarded annually, and these are renewable for 4 years. The primary basis for the Creative & Performing Arts Award is the student's potential for contributing to the quality of the arts at ISU. Reward recipients must enroll as a major in the Department of Art and Design. The award is forfeited if the student changes his/her major. A portfolio or paper is required for the application. All awards require full admission to Indiana State University and a minimum high-school GPA of 2.5. Students may apply to Indiana State University at: http://www.indstate.edu/admissions</p> |
