

Online Master of Biology FAQ

How many credits will I need to complete the online master of Biology?

The master of science (M.S.) in biology includes 32 credits.

What is the curriculum progression?

How long will I be in the program?

This master's program can be completed entirely online in three to five years of part-time study. Students who have the flexibility to blend on-campus and online coursework can complete the program in two years of full-time study.

When are the courses taught?

Courses are offered in the late afternoon or early evening. There will be an online classroom session in which you log in to.
