May 16- 27, 2016 – Crim 416-104 3 CRN 30829 – 3 hours – Professor Lisa Decker - A two-week intensive course on global drug law policy. Eleven students from the University of Zagreb, Croatia will also participate in the course. The course will include fieldtrips and guest speakers and requires students to be available to participate in course activities during the entire two weeks. The class will also require some project preparation prior to the beginning of the class. This class is recommended in conjunction with the Summer 2017 three-week study abroad student exchange trip to Croatia, but either class can be taken without the other.
