The International Studies Advisory Board at Indiana State University (ISU) is pleased to offer two \$1200 scholarships to support study abroad programs in the coming year. The awards will be made on a competitive basis and can be applied to study abroad in summer or fall of 2017 or in spring 2018.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be enrolled in the International Studies Minor at ISU.
- Applicants must have completed at least 30 credit hours of study with a minimal GPA of 3.0.
- The proposed study abroad program must fulfill the following three criteria:
 - Minimum of six credit hours (or equivalent) on site in an ISU–approved program.
 - Minimum of four weeks of residence in the host country of the program.
 - Program must be completed prior to 30 June 2018.

Application Materials

- A completed on-line application.
- A short narrative that includes a brief description of the proposed study abroad program.
- One confidential academic reference letter from an ISU faculty member, submitted through *The Branch*.
