3. New Business
  - a. TEC Officer Elections
    - a. C. Phelps self-nominated for parliamentarian; 15-0-0
    - b. A. Hopple self-nominated for secretary; 15-0-0
    - c. M-A Lee self-nominated for executive committee; 15-0-0
  - b. Possible Brown Bag Topics and Dates
    - a. C. Phelps - NASP president will be visiting soon, perhaps she could address broader topics beyond school psychology – will follow up with E. Hampton.
    - b. M. Crosby recommended CAEP
    - c. L. Tinnerman recommended recruitment surrounding teaching and learning students
    - d. Request to bring more topics at next meeting.
  - c. Undergraduate and Graduate Student Representatives – T. Pantone serves as undergraduate representative. Still looking for a graduate representative.
  - d. Discussion of BCP 1 Requirement & Issues (Judy Sheese) – 2.5 GPA required for teacher education program, but it may not be tracked, is there a process to make sure that undergrads remain eligible? It is also unclear if the GPA requirement is only at admission and beginning BCP 1 or if it should be maintained throughout training. Concern regarding how this requirement can be tracked and what the intent of the requirement is. Recommended to form a subcommittee to discuss this issue – J. Sheese will looking into forming a subcommittee on this topic.
    - a. Questions about students being pre-majors as an unresolved issue from last year – L. Sperry will check on it.

- e. Late Course Adds (Judy Sheese) – students wanted to get into BCP 1 – remind students that they need to take state-mandated tests at the beginning of the summer. Though they receive unofficial scores at the end of their examination, we cannot accept those and official scores take 3-4 weeks to receive.
- f. Proposals – vote to treat them as a block; D. Ballard moved/A. French seconded. Vote 15-0-0
  - a. Question about ESL advocacy as this population was not specifically addressed. Consideration of this population is required for licensure. Group decided to table this discussion till next month when the program is proposed, as the ESL population might be better considered as part of the program’s approach, rather than a specific course.
