9. Assessment Director's Report-Malea Crosby. Reported about opportunities with the EEE Grant. There are 15 partnering school districts participating in one or more components of the project: (a) faculty-delivered career exploration programming for elementary students; (b) middle-school initiatives for ISU students/student groups to talk with students about career paths; (c) development of career and technical education pathways; and (d) parent meetings for MS/HS parents to understand dual-credit and post-secondary options. The parent meetings have been the most requested component. There are faculty stipends and travel funds available for some of the components.
