 - Human Anatomy with Lab (equivalent to ISU BIO 231 & Lab, is preferred, or will also accept, ATTR 210 & Lab)
 - Physiology with Lab (equivalent to ISU BIO 241 & Lab or PE 220 & Lab)
- Statistics (3 credit hours)
 - Statistics (preferred equivalent to ISU AHS 340)
- Medical Terminology (1-3 Credit hours)
 - Medical Terminology (equivalent to ISU ATTR 225)
- Behavioral Sciences
 - General Psychology (equivalent to ISU PSY 101)
 - Life Span Psychology (equivalent to ISU EPSY 221 or PSY 266)
 - Abnormal Psychology (equivalent to ISU PSY 368)
 - Sociology or Anthropology (equivalent to ISU SOC 101)
