**Lecturer I, II, and III**

**General Description**

Full-time or part-time temporary position with a one-semester renewable contract. General responsibilities of this position include provision of effective instruction in specific areas of nursing practice or special assignment that facilitates the goals of the department and program; active participation in professional activities; and service to the department, profession, and larger community. The position reports directly to the chair of the department.

**Qualifications**

- PhD or equivalent degree in nursing or related field, or a Master's degree. One or both degrees must be in nursing
- Current RN licensure in the state of Indiana
- Clinical competence including a minimum of 3 years of practice as a registered nurse
- Current knowledge in area(s) of expertise
- Educational preparation in nursing education and/or experience in teaching at the post-secondary level is/are preferred
- Knowledge of current trends and issues in healthcare and nursing
- Commitment to excellence in teaching and service
- Effective interpersonal skills
- Ability to communicate professionally

**Responsibilities**

- Support the mission and vision of the department and philosophy of the nursing program
- Implement/maintain department policies
- Facilitate learning in the clinical and/or didactic setting to achieve the desired student outcomes (course and program)
- Facilitate the integration of nursing values
- Facilitate the professional socialization of students
- Participate in curricular activities to advance the institutional mission related to experiential learning
- Participate in the evaluation process for personal review, evaluation of clinical agencies pertinent to teaching assignment, and student performance/progress
- Pursue continuous professional development in area of expertise
- Participation in faculty governance at the department level is optional
