

Nursing Major –Baccalaureate Track for Students Entering With R.N. Licensure

Transfer Students

An R.N. student transferring to the Indiana State University RN to BS track in the baccalaureate nursing program has the same consideration for admission to the RN to BS track in the baccalaureate nursing program at the junior level providing that the minimum admission requirements for the major have been met either at Indiana State University or through transfer or equivalent courses from another accredited collegiate institution.

If the R.N. student has completed a portion of a baccalaureate nursing curriculum at another accredited institution, the R.N. student will be held to the same progression, retention, and graduation requirements as matriculating students.
