

College of Health and Human Services Lecturer Achievement Award

Purpose:

To recognize the outstanding academic and professional achievements of a full time or part-time lecturer, who has made major contributions to their profession and the college.

Eligibility:

Eligible candidates for the award are at the rank of Lecturer. The major accomplishments, which make the nominee eligible for this award, must have been achieved while at Indiana State University.

Selection Criteria:

A record of outstanding achievements, including the significance of the nominee's contributions to Teaching, Instruction and/or Instructionally-Related Activities.

Nomination Process:

Nominations may originate from anyone in the College, including self-nominations. Nominations, letters of support, and/or materials should clearly identify how the nominee meets each of the criteria. All materials should be scanned into a single PDF document. Awards will be based on the materials submitted.

Nominations are reviewed and the recipient is selected by the College of Health and Human Services Awards Committee.
