OVERVIEW

2009-2010 MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

American Humanics. The ISU American Humanics Student Association was awarded the 2009 Outstanding Recruitment Benchmark Award from the American Humanics Association. The ISU American Humanics Student Association was awarded Collegiate Chapter Status by the International Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP). The ISU American Humanics Student Association/Collegiate Chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals was named the ISU Student Organization of the Year. Dr. Nathan Schaumleffel was named the ISU Student Organization Advisor of the Year. A new course, Fundamentals of Fundraising for Nonprofit Organizations, was offered for the first time. Nine RCSM/AH students were awarded NextGen Scholarships of \$4500.00 each. Twelve received Focus Indiana Scholarships.

Athletic Training Clinic Updates

The Athletic Training Clinic instated a new computerized drug management system, inventory system, and record keeping system.

Continuing Nursing Education

Program. The Continuing Nursing Education Program (CNEP) embarked with AHEC on a Comprehensive Continuing Education needs assessment

for nurses of the 11 county area served by AHEC. The CNEP completed its ANCC reaccreditation report. The CNEP has had continuing accreditation since 1977 when ANCC began accrediting program in University Schools of Nursing.

Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation.

The addition of two new programs (PA, DPT) necessitated a department name change from the Athletic Training Department to the Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation.

Doctor of Nursing Practice

Program. A doctorate in Nursing Practice was approved by the Indiana Commission of Higher Education, March 12, 2010. The program was also approved for candidacy for NLNAC accreditation on July 20, 2010.

Facility Renovation. The Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation moved into the Student Services Building from the Arena. Renovations are currently underway.

Faculty and Staff Hired for New Programs.

Six faculty, a medical director, a clinical athletic trainer, a physical therapist, and two administrative assistants were hired this academic year.

Focus Indiana Grant. Veda Gregory, Andreas Kummerow, and Leslie Krockenberger received a Focus Indiana Grant for \$7500 to provide women's health services through the SNC for

indigent women of the Light House Mission and Conner House.

Graduate Program Approved.

Graduate students will now be able to pursue a Master of Arts or a Master of Science in Physical Education with Specialization in Exercise Science or Coaching.

Grants and Contracts for Physical Education. Physical Education faculty submitted 19 grant proposals and thus far have been awarded a combined amount of \$83,396. We continue to pursue opportunities in grant funding especially involving childhood obesity.

Health Careers Summer Camp WCI-AHEC conducted its first health careers summer camp for youth ages 16-21 who are enrolled with WorkOne, the Indiana Region 7 workforce development area. 13 students from four of our 11-county AHEC area attended the week-long camp in which they received CPR/First Aid certification, practiced skills such as taking vital signs, heard presentations from a variety of health care professionals, toured Union Hospital and participated in Tai Chi and other stress management activities. Reports from WorkOne indicate that five of the students received CNA certification and one enrolled in the IVY Tech RN program. Workforce Net, Inc. through IVY Tech Wabash Valley provided funding to implement the camp.

Health Care Worker Shortage

Study. A study commissioned by Indiana State University's College of Nursing, Health, and Human Services has found shortages in almost every health care field in the Wabash Valley. Significant shortages were found in nursing, physicians, mental health counselors, physical therapists, occupational therapists, pharmacists, social workers, health educators, speech pathologists, physician assistants and psychologists. In more than three-fourths of the professions analyzed, the study projects that by 2016 the number of health care providers per 100,000 residents will be lower in the Wabash Valley than statewide. The study also found a need for increased access to educational programs, expanding existing programs and making new programs available. changes. The Health, Safety, and Environmental Health Sciences (HSEHS) department has gone through major changes this past year. Three faculty (Drs. Blyukher, Moayed, and Sheldon) have relocated with the Safety Management program to the College of Technology. At the same time, seven faculty (Drs. Behrendt, Clauss, Duerr,

Ivaturi, Kramer, Osborn, and Ms. Reed) and one administrative assistant (Ms. Knott) from the former Family and Consumer Sciences department have relocated to the Health, Safety, and Environmental Health Sciences department. The programs relocating to the HSEHS department are Family Consumer Sciences (general and education), Food Service Management, Coordinated Program in Dietetics, and Human Development and Family Studies.

Health Sciences Adds New Emphasis. The Health Sciences program has added two new concentrations to the Health Sciences major, Health Administration and Environmental Health. The faculty have also worked with the Communication department to create a new concentration, Health Communication. The goal is to have this program approved by fall 2011. The graduate Community Health Promotion program will officially begin this fall and already has 12 admitted students. The program is offered distance ed.

INShape Indiana Conference. Indiana State University's College of Nursing, Health and Human Services, the Indiana State Department of Health and the Indiana Rural Health Association teamed in September 2009 to host the fifth annual INShape Indiana Health Summit. The theme, "Healthy Lifestyles, Healthy Communities,"

showcased the strategies and resources available to improve the health of smaller communities.

Inter-professional Student Learning Planning has begun for the first interprofessional student learning activity involving several departments in the CNHHS and the Terre Haute Center for Medical Education. The activity is being coordinated by WCI-AHEC and will be held on Friday, November 19, 2010 at the Landsbaum Center in Terre Haute.

ISU Field Campus. The 2009-2010 usage of the ISU Field Campus for the seven months it was open totaled 3046 users. Academic use accounted for 55 dates and 837 students. Non-University uses accounted for 108 different groups and 2441 individuals. Sunday Open Recreation Sessions accounted for 284 users; a 40/day average. Revenue for the 7 month period was \$8,460.00. The Field Campus remains a viable and beneficial asset to the University and to the Department.

Master of Science in Sport Management. The revised degree program received approval from the University and the Indiana Commission on Higher Education to be delivered by Distance Education. The Department entered into a contract with the National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association (NIAAA) to deliver a Master of Science in Sport

Management through Distance Education and Credit-by-Examination.

National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission. The Baccalaureate Nursing Program maintains continuous accreditation status for the 2004-2011. Self-Study work resulted in several changes to strengthen the program & outcomes: Increased admission standard for pre-entrance examination (Test of Essential Academic Skills); revised policy regarding assessment and remediation throughout the program; added a mandatory NCLEX-RN review program for graduating seniors.

Physical Education Receiving New Funding for Laboratory Equipment. The funds targeted both repairing broken or nonfunctional equipment as well as purchasing modern, up-to-date equipment to facilitate learning cutting-edge science in the performance and applied fields. The following laboratories were positively impacted by this funding: Biomechanics Laboratory, Exercise Physiology Laboratory, Instructional Analysis Laboratory, Motor Behavior Laboratory, and the development of the Human Physiology Laboratory. The updated laboratories will benefit both faculty and students in research and coursework. Each of these laboratory spaces function as a classroom enabling students to receive hands-on experiences in the discipline,

in addition to being a faculty and student research facility.

Physical Therapy Doctorate (DPT). The Physical Therapy Doctorate was approved by the Indiana Commission of Higher Education and will matriculate its first class Summer 2011.

Physician Assistant Studies Program (MS). The Physician Assistant Studies Program was approved by the Indiana Commission of Higher Education and will matriculate its first class Spring 2011.

Recreation and Sport Management Faculty Accomplishments of Note.

Dr. Thomas Sawyer received the 2010 Theodore Dreiser Distinguished Research/Creativity Award.

Dr. Kimberly Bodey received the 2010 Caleb Mills Outstanding Teacher Award

Dr. Kimberly Bodey received the Indiana Association of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance Sport Management Educator of the Year Award.

Service Learning Course Designation. Six courses in the Baccalaureate Nursing Department were granted Service Learning Course Designation by the ISU Center for Public Service and Community Engagement.

Social Work Community Engagement. There were 21 juniors and 19 seniors providing a total of

10,664.5 volunteer hours to 37 local community agencies. Agencies in which student services were provided include: Covered Bridge Special Education District, Cummins Behavioral Health Services, Department of Child Services (Clay, Know, Sullivan, Vermillion and Vigo Counties), Hamilton Center (Child & Adolescent Services, Wraparound, Assertive Community Treatment Services, Employment Solutions-Spectrum, and Housing Services, Mill Pond Health Campus (Greencastle), Normal Life/Rescare, Regional Hospital Behavioral Health, Rockville Correctional Facility, Shakamak High School (Jasonville), Vigo County School Corporation (Riley Elementary, Sarah Scott Middle School, and McClean Education Center), Visiting Nurse Association, Western Indiana Community Action-Head Start, 14th & Chestnut, Fresenius Kidney Center (North and South), Friends of Families, Gibault, Maternal Health Clinic, Mental Health America of Vigo County, Pace Community Action Agency (Vincennes), Royal Oaks Health & Rehabilitation Center, Ryves Youth Hall Center, Southwest Indiana Regional Youth Village (Vincennes), Southwest Indiana Regional Youth Village (Vincennes), Southwood Health & Rehabilitation Center, and Terre Haute Housing Authority-Family Self-Sufficiency.

Social Work Conferences. Three Conferences were hosted by the Department of Social Work in

Conjunction with Hamilton Center and AHEC with 118 attending the Summer conference, Integrative Cognitive-Behavioral Group Therapy; 192 for Fall conference "When Tragedy Strikes, and 163 for Spring Conference "Ethics and Ethical Decision Making".

Social Work Joint Degree. The Department of Social Work developed an Articulation Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding with Hanil University in South Korea to increase students attending at ISU.

Speaker Series. The Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation held three Speaker Series with inter-professional attendees from medicine, nursing, respiratory therapy, physical therapy, athletic training and radiology technician. An average of 110 individuals attended each session.

St. Ann's Clinic. A rehabilitation clinic was created to service the underserved population. In addition to providing services to patients needing orthopedic rehabilitation, students will obtain clinical experience at this site.

State Health Improvement Plan. Dean Williams was asked to Co-Chair the Indiana Health Improvement Plan by the State Health Commissioner Judy Monroe. Williams has been responsible for facilitating the creation of the Indiana Health Improvement Plan 2020.

Summer Honors Program. The Summer Honors Program was offered

for the second summer in a row that served over 75 students. Students were provided lectures about health care professions, focusing on nursing and social work. Students had agency visits and volunteered in local agencies including: Union Hospital, Hamilton Center, Spectrum Industries, Westminster Village, 14th and Chestnut, St. Annes Clinic, Ryves Hall and Bethany House.

Child Welfare Scholars. There was an increase in the number of social work students interested in the Title IVE program to meet the goal of 5-6 students recruited in the Fall 2010 semester for the next cohort. There were 4 Title-IV students for Fall 2009-Spring 2010. The total tuition paid by the program was \$15,082.00 for Fall 2009 and \$15,757.00 for Spring 2010. The department chairperson and the program instructor met with the Junior class to discuss the Child Welfare Scholars. Senior students who were currently in the program met with the Junior class to share their experiences with them. The chairperson and instructor also met with the sophomore class to discuss the program. Faculty attended recruitment events and visited local high schools to discuss the program. A brochure describing the program was designed and is available in the lounge area of the department. The academic advisor also discusses this option with all prospective and incoming social work students. Six students have

been approved for admission into the Title IVE for Fall 2010.

NURSING, HEALTH, AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENTS

Department of Advanced Practice Nursing. The Graduate Nursing Program (renamed the Department of Advanced Practice Nursing in 2008) at Indiana State University admitted its first students in 1986. It has maintained continuous accreditation by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. since 1989.

The mission of the **Department of Advanced Practice Nursing** is to develop competent, caring nursing professionals and productive citizens practicing in advanced nursing roles in clinical care, education, and leadership. This mission is accomplished through a variety of teaching modalities, experiential learning, research and/or the application of research findings, and community and public service.

The master's program prepares nurses for advanced nursing practice in four concentrations. A graduate of the **family nurse practitioner** concentration utilizes a comprehensive approach to meet the diversified and

holistic health needs of individuals, families, groups, and communities. The graduate of the **nursing education** concentration is prepared to design, provide, and evaluate educational offerings for healthcare settings, community groups, secondary education health career courses, and undergraduate nursing programs. A **nursing administration** concentration graduate is prepared to assume first-line and middle management roles in large health care organizations and middle and upper management roles in smaller health care organizations.

The newly established **Doctor of Nursing Practice** (DNP) Program will be enrolling the first class in Fall 2010. The ISU DNP program will prepare nurses at the highest level of practice for the current health care environment. Graduates will be prepared to critically analyze clinical situations and practice systems, assume leadership roles in the development of clinical practice models, health policy and standards of care, demonstrate advanced diagnostic reasoning skills and clinical judgment through scholarship and nursing practice.

The goal of the DNP program is to prepare expert nurse clinicians and leaders to improve health and health care outcomes through evidence-based practice in diverse clinical, health care, and academic settings. This program's aim is to provide educational

experiences in a interdisciplinary collaborative learning environment, with an embedded scholarly project experience that emphasizes evidence-based approaches for quality and safety improvement in various roles and practice settings and provides students with interactive mentorship by clinical and faculty experts. The ISU DNP program will emphasize innovative and evidence-based nursing practice, applying research processes to decision making, and translating credible research findings to increase the effectiveness of both direct and indirect nursing practice. NLNAC Candidacy was applied for on June 15, 2010.
