## OVERVIEW

### 2010-2011 MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

**Accelerated Second Nursing Degree and Nursing Program Revisions Approved.** The Accelerated Second Degree Nursing Track for students with a previously earned baccalaureate degree in another discipline was developed cooperatively by faculty from both undergraduate nursing departments during the summer of 2010. Revisions to the traditional campus-based Baccalaureate Nursing Track were also completed. The committee consisted of Andreas Kummerow (chair), Tennyson Mgutshini, Marcee Everly, and Linda Walters. The new track and curricular revisions were both approved April 11, 2011. The Accelerated Second Degree and Traditional Track revision will be implemented this year.

**Alumni Appointed to Board of Directors.** Daniel Lucky, ISU alumni and adjunct nursing faculty, was appointed to the Board of Directors as the Health Officer for the Stanislaus County Chapter of the NAACP. This is the first time a nurse practitioner has held this position. Dr. Lucky's role will include strategic planning in health care transformational topics to decrease community-based health care disparities affecting minority populations.

**Applied Health Sciences.** The ISU Board of Trustees approved the department name change to Applied Health Sciences on February 18, 2011. During the past year, the faculty of the Department of Applied Health Sciences has created a new P and T document and a new Constitution. Several program revisions have also been submitted and approved. In addition, the department created a new Ph.D. in Health Sciences (still to be approved by the Commission of Higher Education) and a new

concentration in Health Sciences - Health Psychology. A proposal for a new masters' degree concentration (Public Health Nutrition) will be submitted in August, 2011.

**Awards.** A small committee created several awards that will honor our faculty, staff, students, and community partners. The first college awards banquet will be held in 2012.

**Community Training Institute Developed.** The Nonprofit Leadership Alliance (formerly American Humanics) Program created the Community Training Institute in partnership with ISU Continuing Education to provide non-credit nonprofit leadership and fundraising training.

**Continuing Nursing Education Program.** The Continuing Nursing Education Program (CNEP) was reaccredited by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation for an additional four years (2011-2015). CNEP achieved the maximum length of time that is awarded for accreditation.

**Continuing Nursing Education Program.** The Continuing Nursing Education Program received a 2011 Partnership Matters Award from the West Central Indiana Area Health Education Center (WCI-AHEC).

**Diversity.** A diversity plan was created for the College of Nursing, Health, and Human services. The plan will be implemented during the 2011-2012 academic year.

**Kinesiology, Recreation and Sport.** A new department of Kinesiology, Recreation and Sport was formed by combining the former

departments of Physical Education with Recreation and Sport Management.

**Master of Social Work program proposal (2010).** The Department of Social Work developed a Master of Social Work (MSW) program proposal that was approved by the University and Board of Trustees May 2011. The proposal will now be presented to the Indiana Commission on Higher Education for final approval. If approved, the MSW will be a clinical program with a rural theme throughout the curriculum. Students will be able to choose from two concentrations: health or mental health and addiction.

**Nine Students Inducted into RCSM National Honor Society.** The Recreation and Sport Management Program inducted nine students into the Rho Phi Lambda National Academic Honor Society for Recreation, Parks, Leisure, and Sport Studies.

**Occupational Therapy Program (MOT).** The Master in Occupational Therapy Program was approved by the Indiana Commission for Higher Education for a 2013 start date.

**Physical Therapy Program (DPT).** Dr. Sandra Hendrich and Dr. Adam Yoder successfully completed training by the American Physical Therapy Association and are now Credentialed Clinical Instructors through the Association.

**Physician Assistant Studies Program.** The ARC-PA awarded provisional accreditation to the Physician Assistant Studies Program September 2010.

**Program Awarded Collegiate Chapter Status.** The Nonprofit Leadership Alliance

(formerly American Humanics) Program was awarded collegiate chapter status by Autism Speaks U.

**Program Honored for Second Straight Year.** The Nonprofit Leadership Alliance (formerly American Humanics) Program was awarded collegiate chapter status by the Association of Fundraising Professionals for a second straight year.

**Program Offers new Certificate.** The Nonprofit Leadership Alliance (formerly American Humanics) Program launched a new Collegiate Chapter Certificate in Fundraising program in partnership with the Association of Fundraising Professionals.

**Program Partners with Career Center.** The Nonprofit Leadership Alliance (formerly American Humanics) Program launched an orchestrated partnership with the ISU Career Center to place and pay students through ISU Federal Work Study at several local nonprofit organizations.

**Simulation Center.** An inter-professional Simulation Center was created in partnership with Ivy Tech Community College-Wabash Valley and Union Hospital.

**Speaker Series: Perspectives in Medicine.** (November 23, 2010). The Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation Department has continued the annual Speaker Series highlighting an alumnus Dr. Cindy Trowbridge, who presented on muscular pain *"To Stretch or Strengthen."*

**Speaker Series: Perspectives in Medicine.** (April 27, 2011). The Applied Medicine and

Rehabilitation Department has continued the annual Speaker Series highlighting an alumnus Dr. Malissa Martin, who presented on muscular pain “Osteochondritis Dissecans.”

**Student Leadership Awards.** The Nonprofit Leadership Alliance (formerly American Humanics) Program was awarded four student leadership awards from the ISU Student Leadership Coalition.

**West Central Indiana Area Health Education Center (WCI-AHEC) (November 2011).** An Interprofessional (IPE) student activity was held at the Landsbaum Center for over 100 students from various professional tracks at ISU and 2<sup>nd</sup> year medical students from IU School of Medicine Terre Haute Center for Medical Education. The planning committee, consisting of **Louise Anderson** (AHEC), **Deborah Bartnick** (CNE), Peter Duong (THCME), **Betsy Frank** (BNC), **Cherie Howk** (APN), **Leamor Kahanov** (AMR), **Robyn Lugar** (SW), **Yasenska Peterson** (AHS), **Linda Walters** (BN), and **Peggy Weber** (SW), met during the summer and early fall of 2010 to plan three case studies. Students formed IPE teams to discuss, plan, evaluate and debrief the cases.

## **NURSING, HEALTH, AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENTS**

**Department of Advanced Practice Nursing.** The Department of Advanced Practice Nursing at Indiana State University admitted its first students in 1986, and has

maintained continuous accreditation by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. since 1989.

The mission of the **Department of Advanced Practice Nursing** is to develop competent, caring nursing professionals and productive citizens practicing in advanced nursing roles in clinical care, education, and leadership. This mission is accomplished through a variety of teaching modalities, experiential learning, research and/or the application of research findings, and community and public service.

The master’s program prepares nurses for advanced nursing practice in three concentrations. A graduate of the **family nurse practitioner** concentration utilizes a comprehensive approach to meet the diversified and holistic health needs of individuals, families, groups, and communities. The graduate of the **nursing education** concentration is prepared to design, provide, and evaluate educational offerings as nurse faculty for university nursing programs, healthcare settings, community groups, and secondary health career courses. A **nursing administration** concentration graduate is prepared and develops a cadre of nurse administrator and executive skills to assume first-line, middle management, and nursing leadership roles in diverse health care organizational settings.

The 39-credit **Doctor of Nursing Practice** (DNP) program currently offers one track or program of study; A post-family nurse

practitioner option as the clinical (NP) track. The DNP is offered in an all-online format designed for the busy working professional. The program can be completed in five-six semesters of full-time study. Part-time study will be offered on a space-available basis, but the student is advised that the decision to pursue part-time study will lengthen the time to degree completion. The number of applicants admitted to the DNP program is limited to 20 new students each fall semester. Meeting the minimum admission criteria does not ensure that applicants will be admitted to the program.

The Baccalaureate Nursing Program at Indiana State University admitted the first class of students in September 1963. The Department provides a 4-year program that is designed for students entering without previous nursing education or licensure and an accelerated track for students with an earned B.S. or Master's Degree in another discipline. The mission of the



Department is to develop students who are competent, caring nursing professionals and productive citizens. The mission is accomplished through innovative teaching, experiential learning, research, and community and public service with traditional and non-traditional students in a campus-based setting. The Baccalaureate Degree is recognized as the basic preparation for professional nursing practice, and prepares the graduate as a generalist. Baccalaureate nursing education is foundational for graduate study in nursing. The Program has maintained continuous accreditation by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. since 1989 and is accredited by the Indiana State Board of Nursing.

**Department of Social Work.** The Department of Social Work is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

Department of Social Work Mission Statement: The Department of Social Work at Indiana State University is committed to contributing to the profession of social

work through teaching, research, and community service. The focus of the undergraduate (Bachelor of Social Work) education is on the promotion of social and economic justice and on the development of competent and skilled social work professionals. (June 2010) The Department of Social Work supports the University and College Missions. When the Department of Social Work became a free standing program in 1994, the University was responding to the community's demand for the development of an accredited social work BSW program. Prior to the mid 1990s there were few professionally educated social work practitioners at either the BSW or MSW levels in this region of Indiana and the social service delivery system lacked the quality that was required for providing essential services. The mission and goals of the program grew out of the needs of the community as well as the values of the profession. The Department of Social Work supports the mission of the University and College of Nursing Health and Human Services by providing 1) quality generalist BSW graduates who fill workforce needs; 2) faculty and students who are actively involved in research, community engagement and leadership in the enhancement of service delivery systems at the micro, mezzo, and macro levels; 3) faculty and students global experiences that contribute to the dissemination of knowledge, and; 4) creative partnerships with the local, state and international communities (e.g., Hamilton Center Inc., over 30 local community social service

agencies, Title IV-E state child welfare training, and international partnerships in Morocco, South Korea, and Russia). The social work program's mission statement is truly an extension of the University and the College's mission statements which provides the framework for BSW education and is appropriate to BSW practice. The Department of Social Work supports the National Association of Social Work Code of Ethics, which is consistent with the College's core values of respect, integrity, compassion, health, and performance.
