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OVERVIEW

2011-2012 MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

AHEC Outreach. AHEC collaborated with David Dominguese (AMR) to provide gross anatomy lab experiences to high school students in the Fountain-Warren County and Twin Rivers (Daviess, Greene, Knox, Martin & Sullivan counties) health careers classes. The recruitment/outreach section increased the number of K-12 health career awareness and enrichment programs and extended into more counties than in previous years.

Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation Interprofessional Activity. The

department has participated in several interprofessional activities where PAs, ATs and nurses provided health care in consort, for example: grandparent physicals, NCAA cross country national championships, autism speaks walk, and athlete physicals. Several other projects to promote the interprofessional competencies were implemented including the Health Care Reform Project bringing together over 220 students and 7 faculty from CoNHHS and teambuilding activities among PAs, undergraduate (preprofessional and professional) and graduate AT students.

Enrollment Growth. The College enrolled over 2,500 students this year which is an increase of 1,000+ students in the past four years.

Gerontology Certificate Approved.

The Department of Applied Health Sciences received approval to offer a new Certificate in Gerontology. Students can begin the program starting Fall 2012. **Health Sciences Concentrations Approved.** Two new health science concentrations were approved. An undergraduate concentration in Health Psychology and a graduate concentration in Health Nutrition.

IPE Student Activity. 165 students attended the Feb 24, 2012, interprofessional (IPE) student activity held in the Hulman Memorial Student Union. Students in athletic training, dietetics, human development, medicine, nursing, physician assistant studies, public health/health administration, radiology and social work participated.

Interprofessional Speaker Series. The department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation held two speaker series with interprofessional attendees from medicine, nursing, respiratory therapy, physical therapy, athletic training and radiology technicians from the Wabash Valley. An average of 120 individuals attended each session.

Massage Therapy. The Department of Applied Medicine and Rehabilitation received approval to offer a massage therapy minor which will start Fall 2012.

Master of Social Work program approved. The Master of Social work program was approved by the Indiana Commission on Higher Education. The MSW will be a clinical program with a rural theme focused on two concentrations: health or mental health and addiction.

Nursing Programs Receive Continued Accreditation. The National League of

Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC) inspected the Department of Baccalaureate Nursing, the Department of Baccalaureate Nursing Completion, and the Department of Advanced Practice Nursing in the Fall of 2011. All of our Baccalaureate and Master's nursing programs remain accredited by NLNAC.

Occupational Therapy Master Degree (OT). The Occupational Therapy Program was approved by the Indiana Commission of Higher Education and anticipates a matriculation date for its first class Summer 2013.

Sigma Theta Tau International.

Thirty-four of our undergraduate nursing students were inducted into Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing in 2011-2012.

Student Research. The Graduate Athletic Training Education Program had 10 research presentations between the National Athletic Trainers' Association and American College of Sports Medicine Conferences.

Students Visited South Korea. A

faculty led short term visit to South Korea provided three students with the opportunity to visit social service, health, and mental health agencies as well as cultural and historical sites. Additionally, a group of six (6) social work administrators, faculty, and students from South Korea visited ISU last summer.

Undergraduate Athletic Training Education. The Undergraduate Athletic Training Education CAATE accreditation was extended to 2020-2021.

NURSING, HEALTH, AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENTS

Department of Advanced Practice Nursing. The Department of Advanced Practice Nursing at Indiana State
University admitted its first students in 1986, and has maintained continuous accreditation by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. since 1989.

The mission of the Department of Advanced Practice Nursing is to develop competent, caring nursing professionals and productive citizens practicing in advanced nursing roles in clinical care, education, and leadership. This mission is accomplished through a variety of teaching modalities, experiential learning, research and/or the application of research findings, and community and public service.

The Department of Advanced Practice offers two certificate programs. A post-master's certificate in nursing education prepares graduates to take the nurse educator certification exam. The post-master's family nurse practitioner concentration prepares advanced practice nurses for the family nurse practitioner national certification exam.

The master's program prepares nurses for advanced practice nursing in three concentrations. A graduate of the family nurse practitioner concentration utilizes a comprehensive approach to meet the diversified and holistic health needs of individuals, families, groups, and communities. The graduate of the nursing education concentration is prepared to design, provide, and evaluate educational offerings as nurse faculty for university

nursing programs, healthcare settings, community groups, and secondary health career courses. A nursing administration concentration graduate is prepared and develops a cadre of nurse administrator and executive skills to assume first-line, middle management, and nursing leadership roles in diverse health care organizational settings.

The 39-credit Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program currently offers one track or program of study; a post-master's family nurse practitioner option. The DNP is offered in an all-online format designed for the busy professional family nurse practitioner to excel in an increasingly complex healthcare setting. Scholarly projects completed by DNP students focus on populations in the rural and underserved communities. The program can be completed in five semesters of fulltime study. Part-time study is offered on a space-available basis, but the student is advised that the decision to pursue parttime study will lengthen the time to degree completion. The number of applicants admitted to the DNP program is limited to 20 new students each fall semester. The program graduated its inaugural class May 2012. The program is a candidate for accreditation by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission and will be receiving an accreditation visit fall 2012.

The Baccalaureate Nursing Program at Indiana State University admitted the first class of students in September 1963. The Department provides a 4-year program that is designed for students entering without previous nursing education or licensure and an accelerated track for students with an earned B.S. or Master's Degree in another discipline. The mission of the Department is to develop students who are competent, caring nursing

professionals and productive citizens. The mission is accomplished through innovative teaching, experiential learning, research, and community and public service with traditional and non-traditional students in a campus-based setting. The Baccalaureate Degree is recognized as the basic preparation for professional nursing practice, and prepares the graduate as a generalist. Baccalaureate nursing education is foundational for graduate study in nursing. The Program has maintained continuous accreditation by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. since 1989 and is accredited by the Indiana State Board of Nursing.

The Department of Social Work is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. The Department of Social Work at Indiana State University is committed to contributing to the profession of social work through teaching, research, and community service. The focus of the undergraduate (Bachelor of Social Work) education is on

the promotion of social and economic justice and on the development of competent and skilled social work professionals. (June 2010) The Department of Social Work supports the University and College Missions. When the Department of Social Work became a free standing program in 1994, the University was responding to the community's demand for the development of an accredited social work BSW program. Prior to the mid 1990s there were few professionally educated social work practitioners at either the BSW or MSW levels in this region of Indiana and the social service delivery system lacked the quality that was required for providing essential services. The mission and goals of the program grew out of the needs of the community as well as the values of the profession. The Department of Social Work supports the mission of the University and College of Nursing Health and Human Services by providing 1) quality generalist BSW graduates who fill workforce needs; 2) faculty and students who are actively involved in research, community engagement and leadership in the enhancement of service delivery systems at the micro, mezzo, and macro levels; 3) faculty and students global experiences that contribute to the dissemination of knowledge, and; 4) creative partnerships with the local, state and international communities (e.g., Hamilton Center Inc., over 30 local community social service agencies, Title IV-E state child welfare training, and international partnerships in Morocco, South Korea, and Russia). The social work program's mission statement is truly an extension of the University and the College's mission statements which provides the framework for BSW

education and is appropriate to BSW practice. The Department of Social Work supports the National Association of Social Work Code of Ethics, which is consistent with the College's core values of respect, integrity, compassion, health, and performance.
