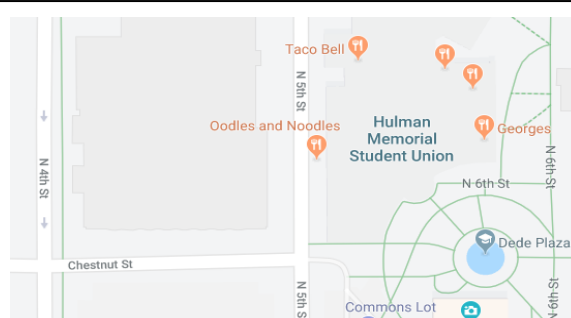

**Keynote Speaker:  
Sandra Burke, PhD, RN, ANP,  
FAAN**

Sandra Drozd Burke, PhD, RN, FAAN is a primary care adult nurse practitioner and diabetes care and management specialist.

Most recently, Dr. Burke served as Professor and Academic Chair for Upper Division programs for Goldfarb School of Nursing at Barnes-Jewish College in St. Louis Missouri. Prior to that appointment, she was Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Biobehavioral Science at the Uni-

versity of Illinois at Chicago and director of the UIC nursing program at the Urbana campus. Dr. Burke’s primary clinical and research focus has been diabetes care and education serving as Diabetes Program director for the Carle Clinic in Urbana Illinois and then as an ANP with a focus on diabetes for the McKinley Student Health Center on the UIUC campus.

Her record of service to the diabetes community spans more than three decades. In addition to serving as lead nurse for the downstate Illinois diabetes summer camp for 15 years, she held leadership positions with the American Diabetes Association and the National Diabetes Education Program. In 2012, Dr. Burke served as president of the American Association of Diabetes Educators, an inter-professional organization dedicated to improving diabetes care through innovative education, management, and support.

Dr. Burke combined her passion for interprofessional diabetes care and education with a similar interest in evidence-based practice. From 2005 through 2008, she was the inaugural BroMenn endowed professor for evidence-based practice at Illinois State University’s Mennonite College of Nursing. In this role, Dr. Burke facilitated EBP amongst staff RNs and was instrumental in developing EBP as a focus for practice at BroMenn and ISU. She continued to work with nursing students and staff RNs to expand EBP throughout central Illinois until her retirement from UIC in 2015.

Dr. Burke became a Fellow of the American Association of Diabetes Educators in 2010 and a Fellow in the American Academy of Nursing in 2014. In 2018, she was honored to receive the Mildred Lemon award at ISU. She received her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Indiana State University, a Master of Science in Nursing from Indiana University Purdue University at Indianapolis and earned her PhD in Nursing Science from the University of Illinois at Chicago.
