- <u>Completed application prior to the application deadline date.</u>
- Earned master's degree in nursing from an ACEN or CCNE accredited program of nursing.
- GPA
- Excellent, compelling, and clear goals with close intersection with <u>DNP (Post-Master's)</u>
 <u>Program Outcomes</u>; well written with evidence of originality/creativity (APA format)
- Excellent recommendation forms with specific references to pertinent competencies, aptitudes, and experiences (academic reference preferred)
- RN Experience
- Leadership roles in healthcare
- Community service involvement
- Scholarly work
