ENG 101 & 105 or ENG 107 - English Composition 1 & 2 (6 credit hours)
CHEM 100/100L – Chemistry (4 credit hours)
BIO 231/231L & 241/241L – Anatomy & Physiology 1 & 2 (6 credit hours)
BIO 274/274L – Microbiology (3 credit hours)
PSY 101 - General or Intro Psychology (3 credit hours)

<u>BIO 412</u> (Pathophysiology) is a course currently required once admitted into the major. Discussion has begun to require BIO 412 as a pre-admission course into the LPN to BSN major. Please consider taking this course if you are looking for additional courses to complete prior to admission into the nursing major.
