Admission Criteria

Applicants must apply to Indiana State University's [College of Graduate & Professional Studies](#) and upload all of the required program application items detailed at [How to Apply](#) prior to the application deadline to be considered for admission.

1. A bachelor's degree in nursing is required. Students in a BSN program may apply in their final semester of baccalaureate studies.
2. Applicants must have an undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
3. English as second language students must achieve the following TOEFL scores or greater: TOEFL – 550 (PBT), 79-80 (IBT), or 213 (CBT). The School of Nursing MSN program does not accept alternate English proficiency tests.
4. A telephone, video, or in-person interview may be required as part of the admission process.
5. Additional materials may be requested for examination prior to admission.
6. Nursing program applicants are considered on a competitive basis. More information on evaluation may be found at [Application Evaluation](#).
