

Meet our Presenter

Dr. Hanlin began his professional career in 1979, completing assessments of delinquent youth including sexually maladaptive youth. Since that time, his professional career focused on youth with



sexually maladaptive behaviors, delinquent behaviors, and/or violent behaviors. During his 35-year career, he helped develop outpatient, residential,

home based, and correction programs to serve these youth. Currently, he is a faculty member for IN-AJSOP (a multi-agency training consortium), which provides a certification for therapists working with sexually maladaptive youth and children. He has frequently presented workshops to professionals on topics related to children and youth with sexually maladaptive behaviors. Recently, he published an on-line chapter on juvenile sex offenders in *The Desktop Guide to Quality Practice for Working with Youth in Confinement Facilities*, developed by the National Partnership for Juvenile Services and Office of Juvenile Justice, Delinquency, and Prevention.
