

Meet the Presenter



Dr. Osborn has been involved in ordained ministry, counseling and higher education for four decades in the areas of addiction, mental health and marital and family therapy. He has professional experience as a Psychiatric Case Manager, Clinical Therapist, Clinical Supervisor, Program Director, and Medical Administrative Officer.

His research publications are in the areas of treatment, scope of practice, ethics, supervision, program administration, policy development, and curriculum in higher education. He has also been sought after as a national conference speaker and consultant to corporations, schools, state and federal government agencies, and churches. He has contributed in consultation and crafting of licensure and national practice standards legislation in Indiana and other states.

Dr. Osborn is certified as a National Board Certified Counselor, and Master Addiction Counselor. He is a member of the Indiana Association of Addiction Professionals, the National Association of Alcohol and Substance Abuse Counselors, the American Counseling Association, the Association for Counselor Education and Supervision, the Indiana Association of Marriage and Family Therapists, the American Association of Marriage and Family Therapists of which he is a Clinical Member. He also holds licenses in Clinical Addictions, Mental Health, Clinical Social Work and Marital/Family Therapy in Indiana.

Professor Osborn has served as the National President of NAADAC, and two terms as Regional Vice President. He is Past President and Chair of the National Addiction Studies and Standards Accreditation Committee. He served as a member of the American Society of Addictions Medicine's Diagnostic and Addiction Treatment Criteria Committee. In 2011 Professor Osborn was selected to lead the first US delegation of addiction and mental health treatment professionals and educators to Cuba, to review treatment facilities and practices. In 2014 Dr. Osborn was appointed to the Indiana Behavioral Health and Human Services Licensure Board. In 2016 Dr. Osborn became the Chair and President. In 2018 his colleagues and former students selected him as the NAADAC National Educator and Professor of the Year in Addictions Counseling for 2018 -2019. He also serves on the Editorial Advisory Board for the publication *Advances in Addiction and Recovery*.
