Heather A. McCabe

is an Assistant Professor at the Indiana University School of Social Work. She also serves as adjunct professor at both the Indiana University Robert H. McKinney School of Law and the Richard M. Fairbanks School of Public Health. She holds a BA in Psychology and English from Indiana University – Bloomington, an MSW from Indiana University School of Social Work, and a JD from Indiana University Robert H. McKinney School of Law. Professor McCabe's research is done at the intersection of law, social work, and public health. Her research translates complex legal issues and research findings across multiple professions to make the information accessible for use by practitioners and advocates in improving population health. She has published in traditional academic journals and has also been sought by media to explain core issues of public health policy. Professor McCabe serves as the Chair of the Law Section of the American Public Health Association. She also has been instrumental in developing interprofessional health education opportunities on the Indiana University- Purdue University Indianapolis campus. She has served as a medical social worker at a pediatric tertiary care hospital. As well as providing direct care, she has served in the policy arena as the Executive Director for the William S. and Christine S. Hall Center for Law and Health at the Indiana University Robert H. McKinney School of Law. Her research interests are primarily in interprofessional collaboration, health policy, and public health.
