Kenneth Pargament is a professor emeritus of psychology at Bowling Green State University and adjunct professor in the Menninger

Department of Psychiatry at the Baylor Medical School. He has published over 300 articles on religion, spirituality, and health, and authored *The Psychology of Religion and Coping: Theory, Research, Practice and Spiritually Integrated Psychotherapy: Understanding and Addressing the Sacred*. Dr. Pargament is Editor-in-Chief of the 2013 two-volume *APA Handbook of Psychology, Religion, and Spirituality*. He was Distinguished Scholar at the Institute for Spirituality and Health at the Texas Medical Center. His awards include the Oskar Pfister Award from the American Psychiatric Association in 2009, the National Samaritan Center Award in 2012, the Distinguished Service Award from the Association of Professional Chaplains in 2015, the first Outstanding Contribution to the Applied Psychology of Religion and Spirituality Award from the Division 36 of APA in 2017, and an honorary doctor-of-letters from Pepperdine University in 2013. He was recently cited as "One of 50 Most Influential Living Psychologists in the World." He is married to Aileen, father of two sons, and is a newly minted grandfather.
