**Indiana State University** is on the move. Located in West Central Indiana, the city of Terre Haute is conveniently accessible to Indianapolis and within three hours of Saint Louis and Chicago. Our city is a regional hub for commerce, arts, sports, cultural events, and medical services and features a children's museum, farmer's market, and the 2010 "Indiana Community of the Year" award. It also has a vibrant downtown located adjacent to the University.

A public university with more than 13,500 undergraduate and graduate students, a faculty numbering approximately 690, and a lower faculty-

to-student ratio (1:21) than many of our peers, Indiana State seeks faculty who value quality instruction, thrive in a collaborative environment of scholars, and embrace experiential learning and community engagement.

The university offers more than 100 undergraduate majors and more than 75 graduate programs within the colleges of Arts and Sciences, Business, Education, Health and Human Services, and Technology.

Indiana State currently has full-time tenure track and instructional faculty positions open, as well as part-time positions. In addition, there is a

Pre-Doctoral Fellows Program for Underrepresented Faculty designed to support the successful transition and launch of doctoral candidates who seek academic positions at institutions with a balanced emphasis between teaching and research.
