The Board of Directors of the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) met January 5-7, 2017, for the purpose of making accreditation decisions. At this meeting, the Board reviewed the Interim Report submitted by the Department of Communication Disorders and Counseling, School, and Educational Psychology, housed in the Bayh College of Education at Indiana State University. This report was required to more fully address a standard cited in the accreditation decision letter that was sent to your office and dated January 23, 2015. The report specifically addressed a standard related to the accreditation of the Clinical Mental Health Counseling (M.S. degree) and School Counseling (M.Ed. degree) programs.

Based on its review of the report and supporting documentation, the Board accepted the report and made a decision to extend the accredited status of the programs through the remainder of the eight-year cycle ending October 31, 2020.
