Course Descriptions: *All courses are Blended Learning, requiring the study portion to be completed online before attending the class. Website links will be emailed prior to the class.

CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer – Full Course

- This course will prepare you to recognize and care for a variety of first aid, breathing, and cardiac emergencies involving adults/children/infants and meets OSHA/workplace requirements. This is an instructor-led course consisting of verbal and video lectures, hands-on practice, and a written final exam with scenario. Certification is valid for 2 years.

First Aid/CPR/AED (Adult and Pediatric)

- This course incorporates the latest science and teaches students to recognize and care for a variety of first aid emergencies such as burns, cuts, scrapes, sudden illnesses, head, neck, back injuries, heat and cold emergencies and how to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies to help victims of any age - adults (about 12 years and older) and pediatric (infants and children up to 12 years of age). Students who successfully complete this course will receive a certificate for Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED valid for two years.

Lifeguard Certification

- At the American Red Cross, our water safety and lifeguarding courses are designed and taught by industry-leading professionals who can help you not only help others stay safe in, on, and around the water, but can help you learn the latest safety and rescue techniques, and deliver critical care, like CPR, first aid, and AED administration, when it's needed most. And although every class varies, each will cover a variety of important skills that can not only help you stay safe and help others enjoy the water safely, but can help you begin, or advance, your career.
