



COVID-19 testing available on campus

Asymptomatic COVID-19 testing is now available at Indiana State University thanks to a partnership with Union Hospital and funding from the state of Indiana.

Individuals who do not present symptoms but wish to be tested can go to Hulman Memorial Student Union's southeast entrance near Dede II at 1-3 p.m. on Mondays and Thursdays. The service is free and no appointment is needed.

Earlier this year, Indiana State made available to students symptomatic testing at the ISU Student Health Center. Students can still go to the Health Center for testing (by appointment) if they present symptoms. This service is also managed by Union Hospital.

Off campus COVID-19 testing for both symptomatic and asymptomatic individuals is also available through **curbsite testing** in Terre Haute. Visit **scheduling.coronavirus.in.gov** to make an appointment.
